The Kimball City Council met in regular session Monday September 23, 2024 at the city office. Mayor Donnie Hamiel called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. Council members present by roll call were Harold Bickner, Matt Bilben, Shelly Janish, Bill Gough, Dayle Blasius, Michelle Chmela. Also present were Nancy Munger, Deb Kourt, Lydia Morley, Theresa Maule, Justus Baxter. Alex Welbig and Paul Kraft were present via Zoom.

Motion by Blasius, second by Bilben to adopt the agenda. All aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Janish, second by Chmela to approve the September 9th regular meeting minutes as written. All aye. Motion carried.

No public input was heard.

Banner Associates representatives Alex Welbig and Paul Kraft presented additional information on the Kimball Main Street Project. The council agreed to go with sixteen-foot driving lanes with the bump-outs and eliminate the bump-outs on Railroad Street, end the project 200 feet before Broad Street intersection with a savings of \$440,000.00 due to drainage reconstruction, redoing the watermains with valves through the intersections at a cost of \$45,000 to \$50,000 per intersection, adding a stub for sewer at Christiansen Park, replace the six inch watermain on Railway with an eight inch at a cost of \$5,500.00, request bids for concrete and asphalt options for the project, and to go with one phase rather than two.

Motion by Chmela, second by Bilben to approve bringing South Dakota Association of Rural Water Systems' leak trailer to Kimball for \$400.00. Roll call vote. Blasius-aye, Gough-aye, Janish-aye, Bilben-aye, Bickner-aye, Chmela-aye. Vote of 6-0 motion carried.

A culvert on Truck Street running from Frosty King goes east to the former Tire Center has a cement box with a lid that is possibly broken and may need to be dug up and fixed. Zach Scott will look at it Tuesday September 24.

Motion by Bickner, second by Blasius to go with CHS this winter and let the mayor do some investigating into it. All aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Bickner, second by Janish that we give the mayor the power to make the decision on the propane with CHS and he can spend up to \$4,000 for propane. Roll call vote. Gough-aye, Janish-aye, Bilben-aye, Bickner-aye, Chmela-aye, Blasius-aye. Vote of 6-0 motion carried.

Motion by Bickner, second by Chmela to establish a new signature card for the city account at First Dakota Bank with William Gough, Donnie Hamiel, Michelle Janish, and Lydia Morley as signers. Roll call vote. Janish-aye, Bilben-aye, Bickner-aye, Chmela-aye, Blasius-aye, Gough-aye. Vote of 6-0 motion carried.

Motion by Bickner, second by Chmela to approve the second reading and approval of the 2025 Appropriation Ordinance 2024-04. Roll call vote. Bilben-aye, Bickner-aye, Chmela-aye, Blasius-aye, Gough-aye, Janish-aye. Vote of 6-0 motion carried. Ordinance printed separately.

Set the next meeting for October 7<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m.

Motion by Chmela, second by Janish to adjourn. All aye. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 9:06 p.m.
