The Kimball City Council met in regular session Tuesday February 17, 2026 at the city office. Mayor Bill Gough called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Council members present by roll call were Shelly Janish, Harold Bickner (telephonically), Angel Stellwag, and Dayle Blasius. Council member Matt Bilben arrived later. Also present were Lydia Morley, Deb Kourt, and Dan Overweg.

Motion by Blasius, second by Stellwag to approve the agenda. All aye, motion carries.

Motion by Blasius, second by Janish to approve the February 2 regular meeting minutes as written. All aye, motion carries.

No public input was heard.

No action was taken on South Central Water Development District check presentation.

Motion by Janish, second by Stellwag to table teeners baseball to the next meeting. All aye, motion carries.

Motion by Bilben, second by Janish to approve the second reading and approval of Supplemental Appropriations Ordinance #2026-01 to supplement the budget \$39,000 for Repairs & Maintenance in the General Fund: Streets Department with the source of funding being undesignated fund balance. Bilben-aye; Bickner-aye; Stellwag-aye; Blasius-aye; Janish-aye; vote of 5-0, motion carries. Ordinance printed separately.

No action was taken on pool pump.

Motion by Janish, second by Blasius to table summer mowing. All aye, motion carries.

Motion by Stellwag, second by Blasius to approve applying for the LWCF Grant for the pool/splash pad project. All aye, motion carries.

Council discussed the chip seal map and options for the 3 blocks next to the main street project. Gough will follow up with Banner regarding this. Overweg was present to ask about paving options in the Kimball West area. Further information will be gathered.

Motion by Bickner, second by Stellwag to approve Mayor Gough signing the lift station maintenance contract with Dakota Pump for \$1,000. Roll call vote – Bilben-aye; Bickner-aye; Stellwag-aye; Blasius-aye; Janish-aye; vote of 5-0, motion carries.

The first March meeting was set for March 2 at 7:30 pm.

Under mayors comments, Gough shared that 4 of the I90 lights were replaced by Muth, the audit is finalized, a tentative bid timeline from Banner for Main St., and an update on the billboards.

Motion by Janish, second by Stellwag to adjourn at 7:31 p.m. All aye, motion carries.
