

Kimball Pool Rules

1. No running
2. No horseplay (ex. Chicken fights/Kill the carrier)
3. No profanity of any kind
4. Pool floats/noodles not permitted (movie night exception)
5. Only one person on diving board at a time
6. Only one bounce on diving board
7. No headfirst entry in shallow end
8. Must be **5 years or younger AND accompanied by person 14 years or older** to utilize the baby pool.
9. Must be **8 years old or older** to swim unaccompanied by a person of 14 years or older.
 - a. Omitted upon completion of basic swim test administered by a Kimball Pool lifeguard.
10. Must be wearing proper swimwear (swimsuit/trunks)
 - a. Swimmer will not be allowed to swim in underclothing.
(ex. Underwear/bra/spandex/etc)

Kimball Pool Safety Regulations

1. Lifeguards are NOT responsible for making sure lifejackets are on children.
2. No lifejackets will be held in pool house, child/family is responsible for providing lifejacket if necessary.
3. Lifeguards are NOT responsible for ensuring swimmer is wearing sunscreen.
 - a. Swimmer subject to be asked to leave if sun exposure passes safety limitations (starting to blister/extreme discoloration)

Kimball Pool Disciplinary Action

Kimball Pool will pose a three-strike disciplinary system.

Daily three-strike system:

1. First strike will be a warning administered by any lifeguard to stop an action or follow a rule.
2. Second strike will be enacted by time spent on the bench (time up to the discretion of lifeguard giving the strike).
3. Third strike will be enacted by suspension of the pool for the rest of the day.
 - a. **Daily strike three will count as one strike on the summer three strike system.**

Summer three-strike system:

1. First strike will be suspension of one day of the pool calendar (based on the daily three-strike system)
2. Second strike will be enacted by suspension of two weeks of the pool calendar. (by violation of the daily three strike system for a second time)

3. Third strike will be considered insubordination to the Kimball Pool rules and will be enacted by suspension for the remainder of the swimming season. (by violation of the daily three-strike system for a third time)

No tolerance system – Kimball Pool has zero tolerance for the following:

1. Fake drowning
2. Inappropriate gestures (ex. Pantsing/causing nudity) of other swimmers or lifeguards.
3. Use of lifeguard supplies (rescue tubes/jumping from the stands)

Failure to follow these zero-tolerance rules will result in immediate suspension for the rest of the swimming season and will not be issued a refund of a pass cost.
